



# **Stewardship Begins with** God's Abundance and Our Response to It

Stewardship is living with the belief that all that we are, and all that we have comes from God, and God has entrusted us to share what we have with others.

Many of us tend to live with a mentality of scarcity. We have limited resources and little time. We live with constant concern about using up our meager assets, whether spiritual or material, and project onto God our own feelings of scarcity. Abundance is not usually the lens through which we view the world.

In contrast, the bible teaches that God intends for us all to have a full, abundant—even extravagant—life. Changing our thoughts from dwelling on scarcity to instead recognizing God's abundance leads to full life, and with full life comes deep gratitude. With gratitude comes generosity. What will be your response to the abundance God has provided to you?

## The Abundance that Surrounds Us is God's



At a bakery a customer ordered, put \$10 on the counter and

left. The cashier tried to get him back to give him his \$2.50 in change. The departing customer said, "Keep it." Great story in itself... but here's what was wonderful. The cashier put \$1 in the cup for staff tips...and the other \$1.50 in a jar for raising money for a local charity.

This one employee chose to both share the \$1 with the rest of the staff and put the other \$1.50 toward charity. As little money as this person had, he believed it was more important to give to this one cause dear to their hearts.

Often there are times in our lives when we somehow receive unexpected funds. Whether it be a generous tip, an unexpected inheritance, a bonus at work, or an extra-large tax refund, these are certainly welcome. But imagine if we all chose to give a portion (or all) of these unexpected funds away. Imagine how we could touch the lives of those around us, and the lives of persons in need in our communities.
