New Business:

- Haunani Wallace is resigning from Vestry effective the beginning of the year. She cited as reasons the responsibilities of being chair of a Rockport committee and her busy schedule. Haunani was thanked for her service.
- With Haunani's resignation, we will need to fill 4 Vestry seats three members for a 3-year term and one member for a 2-year term.
- Read a letter by Doc Wallace followed by a discussion of how inclusive St. Thomas' is. Agreement by all that everyone should have a voice—from both sides of the aisle, regardless of whether they are conservative or liberal, rich or poor. If everyone is not welcome, we fail in our promise to "respect the dignity of every human being." Civil Discourse is important to Diocese, and St. Thomas' is looking at ways to being workshops on civil discourse to the town by offering our facilities.
- Stewardship is beginning shortly. A successful Stewardship campaign is very important to be able to continue our worship. Terry shared her thoughts on how we can explain the day-to-day costs of running St. Thomas' so that our members understand the importance of supporting St. Thomas'. The Rector asked for people to be on the Stewardship Committee.
- Thanksgiving. The Lyles and Mellos will be hosting Thanksgiving this year. An article will be in the October 27th Tidings. The buffet meal will begin at 2pm.

Donovan moved the meeting to be adjourned; Fred seconded. All approved. The meeting concluded with the Lord's Prayer.
