

This week, there will not be a video service from St. Thomas', but you are invited to view the diocese's monthly service. This full service, with music and a sermon from Bishop Brown, was compiled by a diocese-wide team of clergy and lay leaders. It "premieres" on [facebook.com/episcopalmaine](https://www.facebook.com/episcopalmaine) at 10:00 a.m. Sunday, but the link will be available on our website starting Saturday night.

### Update on Reopening

The vestry, task force, and rector have decided to keep the church closed during the month of August. We are concerned about the strong uptick in COVID-19 cases nationwide in states that elected to reopen faster than we did here in Maine. So far, we are one of the remaining states not seeing a precipitous rise in numbers. Maine's more conservative tactics resulted in fewer churches in our area opening for in-person worship. This may have helped to keep our numbers down when other states' were surging.

In the Episcopal Church in Maine, the churches that are reopening to small congregations are primarily doing so outdoors. We don't have the

space outside our church for Sunday services, and a sound system we would have to use would disturb neighbors.

We're considering holding an outdoor service offsite in August. Having it on private property would be easier as the behavior of non-church members could put our parishioners' safety at risk in a public venue. If we do this, people would still need to be physically distanced and masked. Socializing would be done masked and distanced, too. Studies have found that being outdoors doesn't eliminate risk.

We are looking toward September to begin one small service by reservation each Sunday in our church. Again, unless there is a vaccine or medication developed, we would still be masked and physically distanced, no singing would be permitted, and we would be seated throughout the service. We would continue to stream the service for all who are still not comfortable, or unable, to be in the church.

For now: enjoy the virtual coffee "hours" each Monday-Friday morning with fellow parishioners. Noonday Prayer, Compline, and our great service on Sunday morning are there for your spiritual nourishment. We may also add a weekly podcast that anyone with a phone could listen to.

And remember, if you need to talk, please reach out to each other or call the rector, Br. Donovan, Abby, or our phone tree champions: Sarah Groman and Lucy Ebbert. Let us know if you need anything. We are still a church community, and we are still united

by our commitment to each other. You are gifts of God, and you are the people of God to anyone whose lives you touch. God bless.



### Outdoor Worship Spaces

We are creating a prayer garden in the lawn space behind the parish hall. It will accommodate up to four people at a time to sit and pray. Brother Donovan Bowley is making meditation stations to go by the seating areas. People will be asked to wear masks and to physically distance at all times. We hope to have it up by the first week in August.

The garden by the statue of Saint Thomas is always available for quiet prayer or a chat with a friend while socially distanced and masked. The weed whackers have been hard at work to make it ready for visitors.
